C.S. §3802 to include tiered penalty structure</p> <p>Act 2004-177 (effective 11/29/2004) Grade and penalty are determined by the 10 year look-back period for sentences imposed on or after 11/29/2004</p> <p>Act 2012-39 (effective 7/9/2012) Increases grade and penalty when minor in vehicle</p>
